A418 SPEED LIMIT REVIEW. Bucks County Council are currently reviewing speed limits in our area and the public are invited to give their response by 9th January 2009. We would urge you to send your comments in writing to: Legal and Democratic Services, County Hall, Aylesbury, Buckinghamshire, HP20 1UA, or email: lwitney@buckscc.gov.uk. The proposals for revised speed limits for Bierton can be summarised as follows:

- Retain a short length of 40mph speed limit on A418 between Aylesbury and a point near to Church Farm Close
- Reduce 40mph speed limit from that point to the existing gateway where the current 40mph speed limit ends near Hulcott Lane
- Provide a new 30mph speed limit on the whole length of Gib Lane
- Provide a new 30mph speed limit on Hulcott Lane from the A418 to a point (and including) the entrance to Aylesbury Golf Centre.
