Parish Council Notices

Wind Power Station between Wingrave, Rowsham and Hulcott at Bridge Farm, Wingrave

Many residents will already have seen the (very) slim 81 metre high mast recently erected between Wingrave, Rowsham and Hulcott. It supports an anemometer measuring wind speeds to inform a Planning Application later this year for a wind-powered electricity generating station (“wind farm”) at Bridge Farm comprising 8 x 2 MW turbines. Each turbine would be mounted on an 81 metres high column, the blades being 50 metres long; the overall height of 130 metres is twice the height of the County Hall building. The columns will be much more substantial than the trial mast and will be visible across much of the Vale of Aylesbury.

While there is sympathy for the principle of renewable/sustainable energy generation, Wingrave, Rowsham and Hulcott have formed an Action Group to oppose this proposal, on the grounds that it grossly intrusive into vulnerable and attractive countryside surrounded by historic villages and landscape; it would form an alien and incongruous feature within what is otherwise a gentle, open agricultural countryside and would unacceptably dominate much of the Vale. There may also be noise and other adverse effects for residents of Hulcott, Wingrave, Rowsham and the eastern areas of Bierton with Broughton.
